How much do tickets cost?

Where do I buy tickets?

Tickets can be purchased in advance at the convention registration site [here](#), or onsite while supplies last at the SPSP Store on Lower Level 2 of the Hyatt Regency.

What is included with my ticket?

Each ticket includes aquarium admission, hors d'oeuvres, and 1 drink ticket. Student tickets also include access to a Students Only Networking Area.

How do I receive my tickets?

Tickets will be in the form of wristbands – 1 color for nonstudent, and 1 color for student. You may pick up your wristbands and drink tickets beginning on Wednesday afternoon at the SPSP Store on Lower Level 2 of the Hyatt Regency.

Tickets will not be replaced if lost.

Wait, I get a drink ticket with my admission to SPlish SPlash. Is that different from the SPSP convention drink tickets I got with my registration?

Yes, you will receive a drink ticket with your ticket to SPlish SPlash, and yes, these aquarium drink tickets are different from the convention registration drink tickets. SPlish SPlash drink tickets can only be used at the aquarium. Convention drink tickets can be used at the aquarium or the other networking receptions held in the host hotels.

Is there transportation to/from the event?

No, there is no transportation provided. The aquarium is a short 3.5-4 block walk from the front door of the Hyatt Regency. Attendees staying at the Marriott Marquis should cross the sky bridge connecting the Marriott to the Hyatt and exit the Hyatt through the lobby.

Can I buy tickets for someone else?

Yes, in fact, we encourage faculty and other senior career level attendees to purchase tickets for their students. **Group tickets are available.** Contact Nate Wambold at nwambold@spsp.org for more details.

My university will only reimburse me for educational/professional events. Will this be on my convention receipt?

Yes, we understand the need for reimbursements to be for educational and professional purposes only. Therefore, we've focused this event around networking and professional development. Event tickets will appear on your SPSP Convention Receipt as "Aquarium Networking Event."

What is the Students Only Networking Area?

A portion of the venue will be limited access for students only. This area will have its own bar and reception seating for students to mix, mingle, and network separately from the general crowd, if they wish. Students may come and go from this area as often as they'd like throughout the event.
